The teacher is the key element in the educational process. Research shows that over 80% of student success in learning is dependent on the teacher. The teacher is the key to effective classroom management. Behavior management, within the classroom setting, is integral to a teacher's overall capacity to effectively teach and manage their classroom. Workshop participants will gain an understanding of their responsibility to guide the behavioral development and meaningful learning of every student in the classroom and better understand the academic and non-academic factors that impact student behavior.

Participants will:

- Learn why students misbehave and discover interventions for those behaviors.
- Learn strategies to create a classroom of independent learners.
- Identify goals for themselves and their students and learn strategies on how to review and revise those goals throughout the school year.
- Learn how procedures and routines support classroom management.
- Identify rules, procedures and consequences that support student success.
